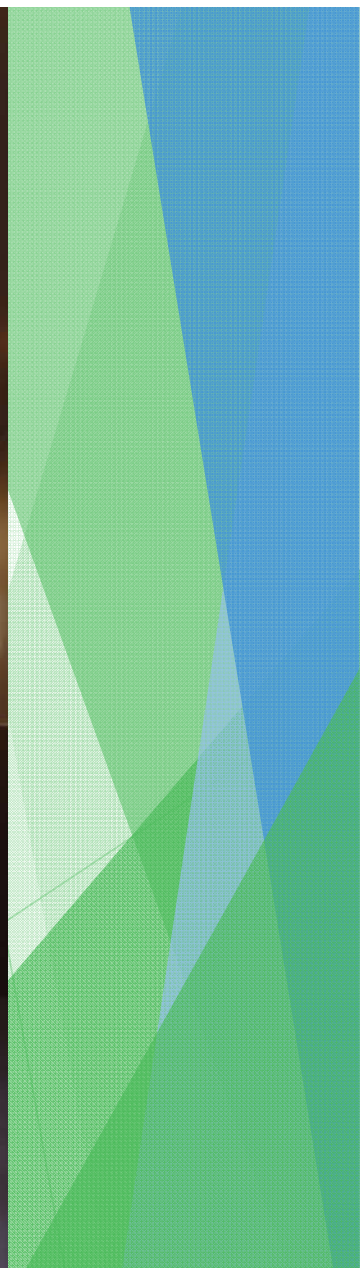

1) The Conference extends support to all victims of terrorist attacks all over the World. We express our categorical rejection of any form of violence and we commit to greater respect for all kinds of diversity.

2) It also symbolizes our solidarity to people and communities suffering the consequences of social, economic and environmental unsustainability, such as forced migration.

3) These days of rich human and academic exchange have served to reiterate our firm commitment to all and each one of the key elements that define social work internationally: an academic discipline and education linked to a practice-based profession that promotes social change and development, social cohesion, and the empowerment and liberation of people, and whose central principles are social justice, collective responsibility and respect for diversities.

d-Structural and organizational conditions and professional status

5) Social workers and social work educators meeting in Paris would like to call the attention of European politicians and citizens to support our intention to promote the qualification standards of social work education throughout Europe as one of the most demanding academic discipline. This concerns also the working conditions of those involved in educating the future social workers, and those that nurturing the best possible learning environment for social work students.
